

Board Acts As a Unit

Only decisions of the Board acting as an entity are binding on the Superintendent.

Accordingly:

1. Decisions or instructions of individual Board members, officers, or committees are not binding on the Superintendent except in rare instances when the Board has specifically delegated such exercise of authority.
2. In the case of Board members or committees requesting information or assistance which, in the Superintendent's opinion, require and redirect a material amount of staff time or resources that would be disruptive or unreasonable, the Superintendent may refer such requests to the full Board for official authorization.
