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Kindergarten Registration Notice

Kindergarten Spring "Round-up" Registration May 3 – 7, 2010

Registration for children entering Kindergarten at **Cape Horn-Skye, Gause, and Hathaway** Elementary Schools for the 2010-2011 school year will be held May 3 – 7, 2010 from **9:30 AM to 4:00 PM** at the school where the child will attend.

Children entering Kindergarten must be five years old on or before August 31, 2010.

Parents must present the following for admission:

1. **Original Birth Certificate**
2. **Proof of vaccinations as required by Washington Law**
3. **A completed, signed Certificate of Immunization Status form**

Washington state law requires school age children to receive specific immunizations in order to attend school. Washougal School District works with the Washington State Department of Health to comply with state law on required vaccinations.

Required documentation

Washington state law [RCW 28A.210.080](#) requires that all children show proof of immunization or certification of exemption to attend school. Students cannot start school without the required documentation.

Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS) form

All students must have a completed and signed [certificate of immunization](#) status (CIS) form on file in the school office. Parents/guardians must complete the form and turn it in to the school before the student can start school.

Students will not be assigned to classes until the CIS form has been turned in with the vaccines required for school attendance documented. The Spanish version of the CIS is available [here](#).

Vaccines required for school attendance

Schedule your child's vaccination appointments well in advance of the new school year to ensure that your child has received all the vaccines required for school attendance.

Vaccination Requirements

Vaccine	Requirement
Hepatitis B	Required for K-12th grade students. Three doses.
DTP, DTaP, DT or Td <i>diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis (whooping cough)</i>	Required for K-12th grade students. Four doses for kindergarten enrollment. Three doses are acceptable if student enrolls in our district after kindergarten. <i>Last dose must be given on or after fourth birthday.</i>
Tdap*	One dose * <i>Only</i> required for sixth graders who have not received a tetanus-containing vaccine (DTP/DTaP/DT/Td) in past 5 yrs.
Varicella (Chickenpox)	Two doses required for kindergarten and first grade students. Verification of at least one dose required for second, third and sixth grade students. <i>First dose must be given on or after first birthday and second dose at least 28 days after the first dose.</i>
Polio	Required for K-12th grade students. Three doses <i>Last dose must be given on or after fourth birthday.</i>
Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR)	Required for K-12th grade students. Two doses <i>Must be given on or after first birthday and at least 28 days apart.</i>
