Students may submit their very favorite image (1). Images will be post on WACA website, WACA FB page and selected images will be displayed electronically at the WYAM Gallery.

Students are encouraged to submit an Artist Statement describing what inspired them and feelings they hope to evoke.

Photographs may be submitted at any time through March 31, 2020, but only those received before March 2, 2020 will be a part of the Gallery show.

All entries can be used by WACA for any purpose and must include this Authorization Form completed and signed by a parent/guardian. Simply fill it out, take a photo of it and e-mail it along with photographs to
