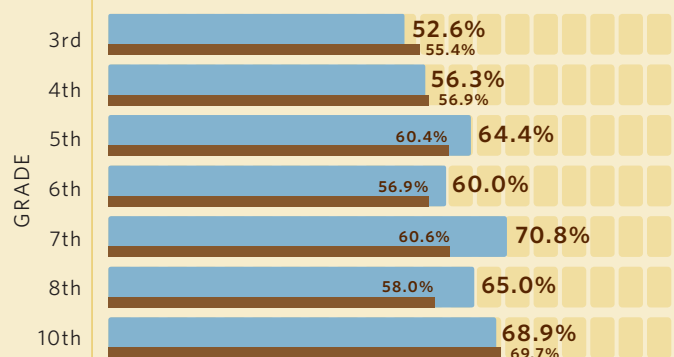

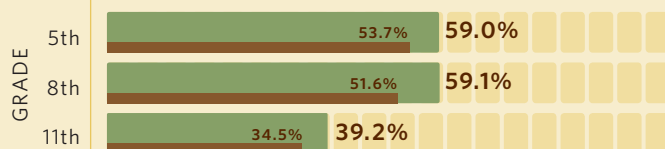

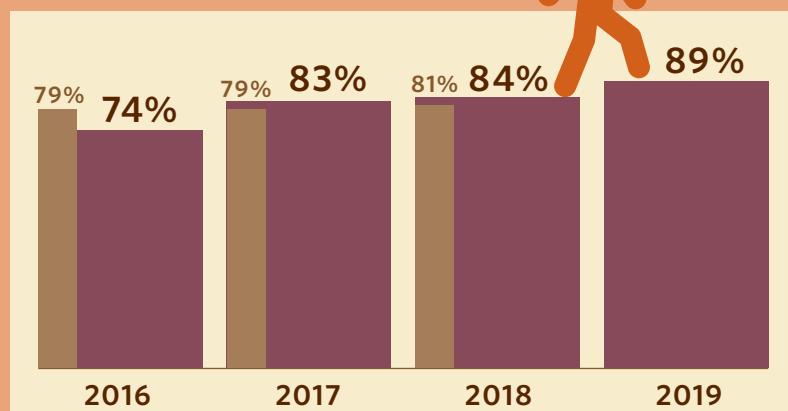

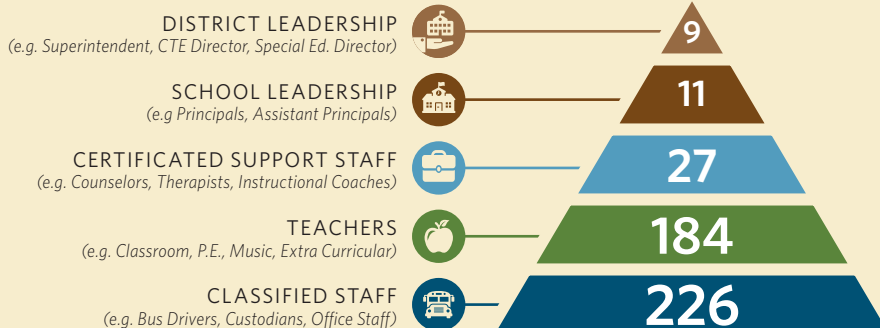


## FREE/REDUCED LUNCH
